Normal ranges vary depending on the reference range used by the lab, but anywhere between 10-20 mg/dL is considered normal. Elevated levels may indicate kidney dysfunction; however, it can also be due to nonrenal factors, such as infections, GI bleeding, dehydration, and excessive muscle breakdown.
