Remember that I need characters on their own layers because sometimes I have to resize them. Now going down the list, Banal is the "Ban All" Fun banner. Fatuous is the Fat Kid sitting in the large Shoe. Hackneyed is the Hacky Sack which are usually multicolored thread material. Insipid is the Insect Pig on the right so color him half like a fly and half like a pig. A pedestrian sign is outside on the left, and that should be colored all yellow with a black character. Platitude is what the insect pig is holding, it is a white plate with a pink tu tu around it. Prosaic is just a Prosaic pill bottle. Quotidian is the Indian in the back making the Quote gesture with his fingers so please make that apparent. Trite is the pile of tridents in the corner. The guy sleeeping next to the pile of tridents is a Broom Medic character. Have fun and email me with questions!
