### NS3/4A Inhibitors

#### Glecaprevir

Glecaprevir is fitting for all genotypes of hepatitis C and is used in combination with Pibrentasvir.<br>

#### Grazoprevir

[Grand-zoo](#)

Grazoprevir is used for genotypes 1 and 4 and is used in combination with Elbasvir.<br>

#### Simeprevir

[Simmering-soup](#)

Simeprevir is used in conjunction with ribavirin and peginterferon-alpha to treat chronic hepatitis C infection.

### NS5A Inhibitors

#### Ledipasvir

Ledipasvir is fitting for all genotypes 1, 4, 5, and 6 and is used in combination with Sofosbuvir.

#### Elbasvir

Elbasvir is fitting for genotypes 1 and 4 and is used in combination with Grazoprevir.<br>

#### Velpatasvir

[Velociraptor](#)

Velpatasvir is used in all genotypes of hepatitis C and is used in combination with sofosbuvir. Velpatasvir can also be used with Voxilaprevir and Sofosbuvir together.<br>

### NS5B Inhibitors

#### Sofosbuvir

Sofosbuvir is used for all genotypes of hepatitis C and is used in combination with Ledipasvir or Velpatasvir.<br>
