(ad-ij)
Noun
A proverb or short statement expressing a general truth

Aphorism

Afro-Raisin

(af-uh-riz-uh m)
Noun
1. A pithy observation that contains a general truth
2. A concise statement of a scientific principle, typically by an ancient classical author

Apothegm

Apple Thumb

(ap-uh-them)
Noun
A concise saying or maxim; an aphorism

Axiom

Axe Gnome

(ak-see-uh m)
Noun
1. A statement or proposition that is regarded as being established, accepted, or self-evidently true
2. A statement or proposition on which an abstractly defined structure is based

Bromide

Broom Maid

(broh-mahyd)
Noun
A commonplace remark or notion; a platitude

Dictum

Duck Tums

(dik-tuh m)
Noun
1. A formal pronouncement from an authoritative source
2. A short statement that expresses a general truth or principle

Epigram

E-Pilgrim

(ep-i-gram)
Noun
1. A pithy saying or remark expressing an idea in a clever and amusing way
2. A short poem, esp. a satirical one, having a witty or ingenious ending

Platitude

Plate Tutu

(plat-i-tood)
Noun
1. A remark or statement, esp. one with a moral content, that has been used too often to be interesting or thoughtful
2. The quality of being dull, ordinary, or trite

Sententious

Sun Tan Fish

(sen-ten-shuh s)
Adjective
Characterized by or full of aphorisms, terse pithy sayings, or axioms

Truism**Truth Prism**

(troo-iz-uh m)
Noun
1. A statement that is obviously true and says nothing new or interesting
2. A proposition that states nothing beyond what is implied by any of its terms
