Topic Definition

### Graphics

Please make the P on the vent in the back stand out well, maybe have a bright shine on it. The Cucumber in the foreground has ink in his mouth so color accordingly. The Fetter should be made of feathers. The fur fence should be like a fur coat color so a dark overall color with a white trim. The hobbit is sort of a prisoner in this scene so make the hand cuffs attached to the N subtle. The character in the back left is a cloud in the shape of an O blowing an O ring with his cigarette. Put more opacity on the ring and make the Cloud slightly transparent, place a subtle badge on the cloud too. Have fun!

In this scene is a list of synonyms for Prevent/Obstruct

**Forfend;** fur-fence; verb; avert, keep away or prevent something evil or unpleasant.

**Occlude;** O cloud O ring; verb; sop, close up, obstruct, an opening, orifice, or passage.

**Encumber;** ink-cucumber; verb; restrict or burden in such a way that free action or movement is difficult.

**Impede;** the M millipede; verb; delay or prevent someone or something by obstructing them, hinder.

**Hinder;** hand deer; verb; create difficulties for someone or something resulting in delay or obstruction.

**Fetter;** feather fetter; noun; a chain or manacle used to restrain a prisoner, typically placed around the ankle. Fetter can also be a verb with the same meaning, to restrain with chains.

**Inhibit;** N hobbit; verb; hinder, restrain, or prevent an action or process.
