### Topic Definition

### Graphics

This one is a fairly large card and needs attention on each attribute. The most eye-catching part of the picture should be the crystal ball of the ogre and the hairy burger. Take some time and put a slight effect on crystal ball, with a glow on or around it. You can color the Augur Ogre similar to Shrek, the ogre with the drill part as a metal. Color the Auspice deodorant red and white. Also remember that the fortune teller is a frog with a pig nose so color green with pig pink nose and fade the colors well. The Presage Press Hog is a reporter and is trying to question the fairy about what is going on, so just put a suit on him and make sure he is pointing towards the fortune teller. ### Dry audio

In this scene are synonyms for the word predict.

**Portentous;** pork-tent; adjective; a sign or warning that something momentous or calamitous is likely to happen

**Fey;** fairy; adjective; having supernatural powers of clairvoyance

**Presage;** press hog; verb; be a sign or warning that something bad will happen. Presage can also be a noun with the same meaning.

**Prescient;** present; adjective; having or showing knowledge of events before they take place

**Prognostic;** frog with pig nose; adjective; predicting the likely outcome of a disease. Prognostic can also be used as a noun meaning an advance indication or portent of a future event

**Harbringer;** hair-burger; noun; a person or thing that announces or signals the approach of another

**Augur;** ogre augur; noun; to foretell or foresee.

**Auspice;** auspice; noun; a divine or prophetic token
