

## Pleasant Sounding

**Topic Definition**

The title character for this scene is the pleasant sound man with a giant smile. He's holding the U-phone up to the snoring nurse and enjoying the pleasant sounds. He should also be holding his free hand up to his ear to better hear the pleasant sounds coming out of the U-phone. His smile and ear need to be exaggerated because he needs to look like he's enjoying the sounds. There is a line cutting diagonally across the scene because it is a phone call between two places. The melon-dice character is playing the harmonica into his U-phone. There should be little musical notes coming out of the harmonica. The pleasant sound character on the other end is using the pleasant sounds coming out of his U-phone to put the snore-nurse to sleep so he can escape from the hospital. The melon-dice character has dice for eyes and needs to look like a watermelon. The U-phone must have an apparent U in the handle, so the U should be greatly exaggerated and a different, brighter color than the rest of the phone. The snore-nurse must look like nurse who is snoring with little Z's coming out of her.

**Graphics**

Dan this one should be fairly simple. Nothing too much to explain just make sure different character colors contrast well. Note there should be a line through the middle of the pic like its a phone call happening. Also if you want to get creative you can try throwing in a soothing background because it is Pleasant Sounding. But that's just optional. Have fun!

**Dry audio**

In this scene is a list of synonyms for pleasant sounding.

**Euphonious** the U-phones; adjective; pleasing to the ear.

**Harmonic** harmonica; adjective; of, relating to, or characterized by musical harmony. &nbsp; Harmonic can also be a noun meaning an overtone accompanying a fundamental tone at a fixed interval.

**Melodious** the melon notes; adjective; of, producing, or having a pleasant tune. Pleasant sounding, a melodious voice.

**Sonorous** snore; adjective; of a person's voice or other sound, imposingly deep and full.
