Diffidence; the daffodils; adjective; lack of self-confidence

Gaucherie; the goose-cherry; noun; awkward, embarrassing, or unsophisticated ways

Foible; football; noun; a minor weakness or eccentricity in someone's character

Contrition; con-tissue; noun; the state of feeling remorseful and penitent
