Cryptic

Crypt Keeper

(krip-tik) **Adjective**. 1. Having a meaning that is mysterious or obscure. 2. Of a crossword having difficult clues that indicate the solutions indirectly.

(in-skroo-tuh-buh l) **Adjective**. Impossible to understand or interpret; impenetrable; mysterious.

(per-pleks ing) **Verb**. 1. Complicate or confuse a matter. 2. Of something complicated or unaccountable cause someone to feel completely baffled.

(ab-stroos) **Adjective**. Difficult to understand; obscure.

(am-big-yoo-uh s) **Adjective**. 1. Unclear or inexact. 2. Of language open to more than one interpretation; having a double meaning.

(ahr-keyn) **Adjective**. Understood by few; mysterious or secret.

Eskimo-Turret

(es-uh-ter-ik) **Adjective**. Intended for or likely to be understood by only a small number of people with a specialized knowledge or interest.

(par-uh-dok-si-kuh l) **Adjective**. Seemingly absurd or self-contradictory.

Enigmatic

(en-ig-mat-ik) **Adjective**. Difficult to interpret or understand; mysterious.

Obscure**O-Skewer**

(uh b-skyoo r) **Adjective** 1. Not discovered or known about; uncertain. **Verb** 2. Keep from being seen; conceal.

Bemusing**Bee-Moose**

(bih-myooz) **Verb** Puzzle, confuse, or bewilder someone; her bemused expression.

Opaque**O-Picks**

(oh-peyk) **Adjective** 1. Not able to be seen through; not transparent. **Noun** 2. An opaque thing or substance.

Recondite**Raccoon-Dice**

(rek-uh n-dahyt) **Adjective** Of a subject or knowledge little known; abstruse; recondite information.
