Topic Definition

This scene is set in a copy center, so it's important to have a sign up that says that. There are twin counts behind the counter, as they own and operate the place. It needs to be apparent that they are counts, so exaggerate their collars, capes, and fangs. Also pay attention to coloring, like pale skin. They've got an arm around each other. Each is pointing with his free hand and laughing at what a couple of customers are doing in front of them. One customer is Queen-S. She needs to look like a queen, so make her crown apparent and make her dress look royal. Her dress also needs to have S's worked into it. She's stuffing her head into the copy machine and smiling to make a copy, so she can fax her smile. She's operating the copy machine with a big, bright pink cursor. It should look like the cursor from a computer screen, except she's holding it. The M-mule behind her is what she rode to get here. It must have a big M branded onto his shoulder. He's not too happy about her riding him, so he's taking this opportunity to emulate her body position to make fun of her. One count is pointing at the queen and the other is pointing at the M-mule, and they're laughing. On the side of the copy machine is a fax machine that says fax on it. A tissue from a nearby tissue box is being sucked into the fax machine to be printed on. The tissue box says tissue on it. The queen's smile is coming out of the fax machine. The queen's viking guard came with her on this trip, and the viking brought his viking child. This copy center has a flight simulator for customer's children. It should look like a flight simulator with a joystick, pedals, and throttle. It should also say simulator game across the top. The viking is experiencing the simulator vicariously through his child, so he should look excited. On screen is a dime parachuting out of an airplane. It needs to be apparent that it's a dime.
