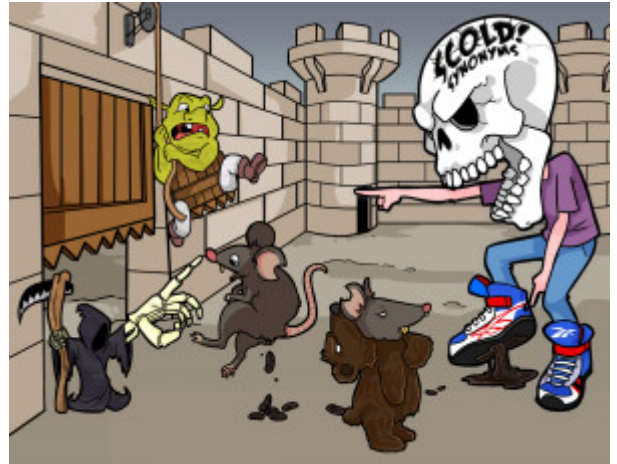


Scold Synonyms

Berate

(bih-reyt) Verb Scold or criticize someone angrily; my son berated me for not giving him a Jewish upbringing

Rebuke

(ri-byook) Verb 1. Express sharp disapproval or criticism of someone because of their behavior or actions Noun 2. An expression of sharp disapproval or criticism

Reprove

(ree-proov) Verb Reprimand or censure someone

Reprehend

(rep-ri-hend) Verb Reprimand

Objurgate

(ob-jer-geyt) Verb Rebuke severely; scold

(kas-ti-geyt) Verb Reprimand someone severely
